2. Which different types of transportation can you see?

3. What shape are the different vehicles?

4. This picture was published in December. What is the connection between this time of year and what we can see?

5. The picture was published in 1931 and shows people travelling from a place with rain in the West to a sunny place in the East. Where do you think these places are? (There is a clue in the title of the picture: ישראל לארץ – To the Land of Israel)

6. Around the time this picture was published many Jews left their homes and immigrated to the Land of Israel. What historical events caused Jews to move to Israel?

7. The artist Nachum Gutman drew many pictures describing life in Israel in the beginning of the twentieth century. Search the internet for pictures he drew and choose one picture that you particularly like. Describe the picture and explain why you chose it.
