Dear Ms. Fleming,

Your manuscript entitled "Behaviorally-oriented intensive aphasia program: Collaboration leads to optimal outcomes"

which you submitted to Seminars in Speech and Language, has been re-reviewed.

You have addressed many of issues raised by the reviewers but the writing still needs some work before it can be considered of publication quality. I would suggest asking someone who is experienced in publishing academic papers to review your work and to provide you with line by line editing. This is beyond the scope of the reviewers here who prioritize content and scientific rigor. Things to consider are transitions between paragraphs, making sure to use primary references, ensuring that the reporting is factual and agnostic and without hyperbole. There are books dedicated to the process of academic writing if you would prefer to take that route in lieu of asking a colleague with experience.
