Please provide the editors with a **Word file** as well as a **PDF file** created by you on the basis of the Word file (to avoid misunderstandings of special diacritic signs).

Every **illustration** must be provided as a single file, preferably in ".tif" format. Colour illustrations are not possible.

All **abbreviations** of literature must be listed at the end of the article including full bibliographical data.

The **text-block** measures 12×20 cm.

Font: Times New Roman Unicode (to be used for Latin, Greek, Hebrew, Arabic and Russian). – Syriac, Ethiopian and other characters might be used after consultation with the editors and the publisher.

Font colour must be black (as well for tables and web addresses [not underlined]; grey might be used in rare cases for differentitaion).

Font size

standard: 10,5 ptheadline of the article: 14 pt (bold)foot-notes: 9,5 ptheadlines within the article: 12 pt (bold) and/or 10,5 pt.caption of illustrations: 9,5 pt

Line spacing: 1,1×

Do not use primes (".	", '') or slo	oped pri	mes ("	", '') as quotation marks.

Paragraphs: The first line of the first paragraph after a heading or after a free line is set flush. The first line of further paragraphs is indented (0,5cm).

Numbers: For connecting continuing or inclusive, numbers, use the **en dash** (–), not a hyphen (-): pp. 5–10, 1801–14 or 1801–1814; not pp. 5-10.

Bibliographical references

Basically, you have two options for bibliographical references:

1. "name, year" :	Postgate, 1999: 123
2. "name, short title" :	Postgate, BiOr 34 (2001) 123;
	Sigrist, Ninurta à Nippur, 123.

In both cases, a comma should follow after the name of the author.

Bibliography

Every article should be provided with a full bibliography of all sources quoted. The bibliography should be set in the flush-and-hang style (tab stop 0,5 cm). Second and further titles of the same author should start with an $m \operatorname{dash}(-)$. In case of multi-author publications, the names of the authors should be separated by a slash (/). Titles of articles are surrounded by quotation marks. Titles of books are set in italics. Titles and abbreviations of series and periodicals are not set in italics. Following the place of publication, names of publishing companies (not required) might be indicated after a colon (e.g.: Wiesbaden: Harrassowitz).

Quotations of more than three lines (extracts) should be indented 0,5 cm on the right and on the left side, set in the same type size as the standard text and be separated by half a line (6 pt) from preceding and following text.

Sumerian text: normal font, not bold font font; spacing Sumerian is OK, but not recommended due to complexity (šu du₇ nam-he₂ he₂-gal₂-la buluĝ₃ -ga₂);

Sumerian logograms used as determinatives: normal raised small letters (^deš18-tár, ^{anše}ku-dini);

Akkadian text: italic letters; numbers, brackets, exclamation marks, question marks are not set in italics (*a-di* 2 *și-me-te ša*^{*i*} *iš*^{*i*}-*tu*^{*i*} [*li-mu*] ^I*A-bat-t*[*u*]);

Akkadian phonetic complements: italic raised letters (*i*-pul^{ul});

Sumerian logograms within Akkadian text: normal capital letters (a-na ÉRIN.MEŠ):

Hittite text: small letters set in italics;

Akkadograms in Hittite: capital letters set in italics;

Sumerograms within Hittite context: normal capital letters;

Latin text is set in italics;

Greek, Hebrew and Arabic text is never set in italics.

Editions of text imitating the line breaks of the original text: *Tab stops*: 1cm right-adjusted, 1.3 cm left-adjusted



These two styles might serve as suggestions. Modifications are possible, of course.

Illustrations (photos and drawings) might be distributed throughout the text. Special plates for photos are not necessary (but might be used, of course). Please take care to avoid the moiré effect! Line drawings (i.e. those illustrations which consist only of black and white elements and to not contain grey colours) should be scanned in bitmap format (otherwise areas which might look "white" could bear a slight grey touch, visible only in the final print!).

Every volume must be provided with indices, depending on the character of the volume; e. g. subject index, index of discussed words, index of quoted passages, index of names (e. g. locations, persons, gods), index of quoted authors.

Embedding of illustrations within *Word* and transformation into a PDF file

Please **compare the resolution of the illustrations** of the final PDF file with the resolution of the illustrations when viewed in e.g. photo-shop. In case the illustrations are embedded correctly, the resolution should not be different; i.e.: the visual appearance should not differ, even if the view/sight is extremely enlarged. The resolution of illustrations might be downsized on two occasions, *which both must be avoided* (!):

a) while embedding the illustrations in Word,

300-600 dpi

b) when transforming the Word file into a PDF file.

600-900 dpi
