Our 2021 priorities focus on our three central areas of impact – Aliyah, Connect Jews Worldwide and Strengthen Israeli Society – to increase the organization's global reach and expand on the crucial role we have played throughout COVID-19.

Aliyah

Reunite Ethiopian families in Israel

Bring home the Ethiopian Jews approved for Aliyah by the Government of Israel (GOI), fully executing Operation Zur Israel by Spring 2021, reuniting thousands of Ethiopians with their families in Israel.



2,000Ethiopian Jews come home by mid-2021 in Operation Zur Israel

Boost Aliyah among young professionals

Fortify Israel by tapping into the rising demand for Aliyah of young professionals who are in demand in Israel's job market (such as doctors, engineers, etc.).
