> PhD in Arabic Language and Literature. I have studied a 3-year PhD program in Arabic Language and Literature. I passed all courses with a very good Degree. My PhD thesis was an analytical account about the freethinking Arab poet Abu Al-'Alā' Alma'arrī (1057 AD). As his poetical collection contained a vast body of topics of pure philosophy, Islamic theology, linguistics, and cultural issues, I used some modern analytical approaches that flourished among western scholars to produce a new analytical account. The thesis was entitled in Arabic, "Epistemology Alma'qūl wal Lāma'qūl fi "Al-Luzūmiyyāt". This is a title which can be rendered as the epistemology of what is reasonable and what is unreasonable in the poetical collection, "Al-Luzūmiyyāt." It was defended on 2002/12/02 with an excellent rank and it was greatly praised by authorities in modern Arabic literature in many aspects of linguistics, text analysis, philosophical and literary criticism. It contained three chapters; the first was about the history of the epistemology and theory of knowledge. It started from Greek philosophy through Arabic medieval philosophy and modern western philosophy, concentrating on the common problems that were the subject of "Al-Luzūmiyyāt". The second chapter focused on the philosophical problems of "Al-Luzūmiyyāt" as the 'Free Will' problem and the philosophy of values and existence. The third chapter was about applying modern text analysis theories and approaches to some selective poems from "Al-Luzūmiyyāt."
