To keep myself abreast of what is happening on a global level in our profession, on and off I have been a member of the Editorial Freelancers Association, the United States (EFA). In summer 2015, the Editors Association of Canada organised its first international conference 'Editing Goes Global' in Toronto. I was one among the only four Indians to have attended this conference.
